1. Purpose

1.1 This report provides headlines about recent TBAP executive activity and details the progress of TBAP strategic objectives.

2. TBAP 2020 Vision - Principle 1

SUCCESS FOR LEARNERS BY ANY MEANS

“We design and adapt so that success for young people is a non-negotiable”

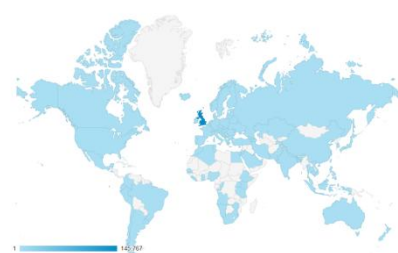
2.1 Local Advisory Boards (LABs) continue to meet for each AP Academy. The Head of School Term 6 reports on the quality of Personal Development, Behaviour and Welfare to the LABs are included in the Board papers for information. All LAB reports, agendas and minutes are published on the TBAP website: <http://www.tbap.org.uk/the-trust/lab-agendas-minutes-meetings.php>

2.4 The planning application for the TBAP Hub building project is due to be heard at the LBHF planning committee on June 13th. If planning permission is granted we are on course to commence the project over the summer with a completion date of summer 2018. Staff are working hard to plan for the decant of Bridge KS4 learners in September with a number of joint projects in place for this term.

2.5 I am delighted to inform you that we were successful in our bid to set up a North West regional hub. We have formed a project group which meets in the North West on a monthly basis. I am pleased to announce that Karen Thomson has been appointed as Executive Headteacher for the North West. Karen is currently Headteacher at New Horizons AP School in Warrington. Karen will join the Executive Leadership team and will begin to build the North West Hub over the next year. We are expecting New Horizons to join the TBAP Trust in September.

- 2.6** We are planning to submit a bid to the DfE Strategic School Improvement Fund with a focus on supporting literacy interventions in AP/PRU's.
- 2.7** We are expecting Aspire AP Academy in Harlow to join the TBAP Trust in September. TBAP Aspire will join TBAP East.
- 2.8** Following closure of the TBAP residence in April we have redeployed all staff. We still retain the building and are actively exploring ways in which we might be able to utilise it to support all TBAP Academies.
- 2.9** The TBAP Foundation continues to support a wide range of additional activities across the Trust. Most recently, grants have been made to provide books to Beachcroft AP Academy. You can see further work of the TBAP Foundation on the website www.everychildachance.co.uk and on the TBAP Foundation facebook page.
- 2.10** TBAP delivers great outcomes and our young learners consistently articulate the value of our offer when they act as ambassadors to visitors. We celebrate the varied and diverse achievements through our blog and Twitter feed on the TBAP website. The local advisory board reports detail the many learner achievements across TBAP but I would like to bring particular attention to the following projects that have occurred since my last report in March:

- New gardens at Unity and Courtyard
- TBAP Primary Residential
- TBAP 16-19 Spanish Residential
- Exceptional learner ambassadors
- Social media: we use a range of channels to communicate with learners, families and other stakeholders. These include a blog, Twitter feeds and website. Over the last year we have had 262,780 visits to our website from more than 124 countries. We have 2,873 followers on Twitter with over 83 individual TBAP Twitter accounts



- 2.11** The learner population across TBAP is summarised in **Appendix A**. The learner population remains at an expected level and will grow as the year progresses. There are currently 487 learners on roll across TBAP. We place learners in the most appropriate provision to meet their needs as an individual and have a number of learners who are attending a TBAP provision that is not situated within their home borough. These placements are reviewed by TBAP RLTs on a regular basis to ensure individual needs are successfully met.

3. TBAP 2020 Vision - Principle 2

PRECISE INCLUSION

“We listen to our learners, seeking to understand their ‘journey’ and difficulties in their lives that make engagement a challenge.”

- 3.1 I am delighted to announce that Wasim But has been appointed as TBAP Lead for Assessment. Wasim will spend 3 days a week working to ensure TBAP Progress 5 measures are in place across all TBAP academies and that progress is being reported on.
- 3.2 There are a total of 89 learners with Education Health and Care Plans or statements across TBAP. Table 6 details the SEN breakdown for each LA and annual review dates.
- 3.3 The TBAP TSA continues to make exceptional progress. Please see the enclosed report for a summary of progress against the 6 strands this term. Sarah Hardy has resigned as Head of the teaching school. I am sure the Board will join me in thanking Sarah for her exceptional contribution to TBAP over the last 7 years. We are currently looking at developing a new Executive Lead for School Improvement.
- 3.4 Therapy continues to be delivered across TBAP academies and the therapists are beginning to make a real impact on the mental health of learners and staff. Jackie Lindeck produces a monthly report detailing outcomes which is reviewed at ELT.

4. TBAP 2020 Vision - Principle 3

STARTING AT GREAT

“For our learners there is no ‘good enough’, we are committed to being exceptional in every respect”

4.1 Our aim is for every TBAP Academy and service to be rated as Outstanding by Ofsted. All TBAP Academies undergo an annual Challenge Partners’ Review which gives us a very clear indication of which areas require improvement or further development. The following table summarises TBAP sites today:-

4.2 1 Ofsted inspection has taken place at TBAP Academies since the last report. I would like to congratulate Krishna Purbhoo, Tony Meehan and the team for achieving a judgement of Good in all areas at Latimer AP Academy.

4.3 Unity Academy received a Challenge Partners visit in May with an excellent outcome. All areas were judged as Good with some fantastic recognition of the progress the academy has made under the leadership of Angela Tempany and Jane Lancaster-Adlam.

4.4 We are currently intervening for an external consultant to lead the development of our bespoke ‘TBAP’ AP/Special review package.

- 4.5** All academies and services across TBAP are following the same self-evaluation and monitoring cycle. All teams are working to the TBAP and local development plans which are uploaded on Bluewave Swift. All local development plans have been revised to reflect the TBAP 2020 vision. All sites have produced a school self-evaluation forms (SEF) which have been forwarded to the Board and are uploaded on each Bluewave Swift deployment.
- 4.6** The TBAP extended leadership met with Board Trustees for an away day and further updated progress against the TBAP Trust wide development plan. Work began on the identification of TBAP values, with input from all staff across the Trust, these have been agreed as: Resilience, Compassion and Innovation.
- 4.7** TBAP Learner Progress Observations (Lesson Observations), Learner Classroom Checkpoints (learning walks), Learner Progress Portfolio Check Point (book-looks and work scrutiny) are ongoing in all TBAP academies. HoS reports to the LAB should be consulted for summary positions. We are reviewing these processes as we introduce our new approach to the assessment of teaching and learning this year.
- 4.8** I continue to attend Regional Headteacher Board (HTB) meetings chaired by the Regional Schools Commissioner, Martin Post. In this role we review Free School and Academy applications and consider underperforming academies or trusts. The TBAP Trust is paid by the DfE for this work.
- 4.9** I have been invited by the British Council to deliver a workshop on Social /Medical Inclusion at a conference of African Policy makers in South Africa
- 4.10** I have been invited to become a Leadership Fellow at the College of St George at Windsor Castle. I attended a residential on “leading a winning team” which I found to be extremely inspiring
- 4.11** My role as a Youth Justice Board member continues, with Charlie Taylor recently appointed as the new Chairperson.
- 4.12** This year I have shared, or am scheduled to share, the TBAP model and the many achievements of staff and learners at the following forums:-

 - Speaking YJB Convention
 - Speaking Capita AP conference
 - Speaking Life without Levels
